Historically, in the 30's Kearney was home to the then largest barn in the world known as the 1,733 Barn of which this iconic barn reflects a rich history of commerce by marking the mid-point of 1,733 miles to both San Francisco and Boston.

Kearney's character, shaped by pathfinders and pioneers, can be described as progressive and determined. The midwestern work ethic is alive and well with Nebraska having one of the highest workforce participation rates in the country; Everyone claims to have work ethic, but having one of the highest workforce participation rates proves it!




